Key Databases:

★Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals

The Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals indexes more than 2,000 periodicals published worldwide on archaeology, city planning, interior design, and historic preservation, as well as architecture. Coverage is from the 1930s (with selective coverage dating back to the 1860s) to the present.

Art Full Text and Art Index Retrospective

Indexes articles, reproductions and illustrations in 579 periodicals published 1929-present, in a wide range of topic areas landscape architecture and garden history. "Art Full Text" covers 1984-present. "Art Index Retrospective" covers 1929-1984. These databases may be searched separately or simultaneously.

BuildingGreen Suite

The BuildingGreen Suite contains three research tools. Articles, reviews, and news from *Environmental Building News (EBN)* are integrated with product listings from the *GreenSpec* products directory and project case studies from the High-Performance Buildings Database.

Cambridge Scientific Abstracts

Provides access to several environmental science databases.

Dissertation Abstracts (with Proquest Dissertations and Theses Full Text)

Indexes every doctoral dissertation completed in the U.S. at accredited institutions for the last 150 years. Includes some master's theses and foreign language dissertations. Full text of many titles included.

GroveArt

A 'dictionary database' with good coverage of landscape architecture history and allied fields, with links to more websites and images.

Web of Science

Includes Science Citation Index, Social Science Citation Index, and Arts & Humanities Citation Index. Provides citations to articles as well as cited references. Useful for tracing the influence of a particular author or idea over time.

Academic Search Premier and Lexis-Nexis Academic

These databases cover a broad variety of topics and contain substantial amounts of full text material. Particularly useful when beginning research on interdisciplinary topics.
