These databases are accessible from the UF Architecture and Fine Arts Library website <http://www.uflib.ufl.edu/afa> or by using the database locating tools available at <http://www.uflib.ufl.edu/databases.html>. There may be many other useful databases, depending on your research subject. Always feel free to consult library staff for assistance with your search for information.

### **Art Full Text**

Provides indexing for over 450 leading art periodicals. Covers 1984-present. Full-text HTML and PDF files available for select publications back to 1997. Also serves as a comprehensive index of art reproductions that appear in the cited publications. For indexing prior to these years, use *Art Index Retrospective* database (see below), or search these files simultaneously.

### **Art Index Retrospective, 1929-1984**

This is the “backfile” of *Art Full Text*. Indexes articles, reproductions and illustrations in over 560 periodicals published 1929-1984, in a wide range of topic areas including art, architecture, craft, decorative arts, landscape architecture, motion pictures, museology and others. May be searched simultaneously with *Art Full Text* (see above).

### **Arts and Humanities Citation Index**

Indexes leading journals in the humanities and the arts. Traces cited references (footnotes) and authorship from 1975 to present.

### **Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals**

The *Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals* indexes more than 2,800 periodicals published worldwide on archaeology, city planning, interior design, and historic preservation, as well as architecture. Coverage is from the 1930s (with selective coverage dating back to the 1860s) to the present.

### **BHA – Bibliography of the History of Art**

Covers European and American art from late antiquity to present, *Bibliography of the History of Art (BHA)* indexes and abstracts art-related books, conference proceedings, dissertations, exhibition catalogs, and articles from more than 4,500 periodicals from 1973 forward. *BHA* extends the coverage of its predecessors: *RAA (Repertoire d'Art et d'Archeologie)* and *RILA (International Repertory of the Literature of Art)*.

### **CAMIO – Catalog of Art Museum Images Online**

Provides digital content contributed by leading museums from around the world. Includes about 95,000 works of art—photographs, paintings, sculpture, decorative and utilitarian objects, prints, drawings and watercolors, jewelry and costumes, textiles and architecture.

### **Grove Art Online (Grove Dictionary of Art Online)**

Comprehensive online encyclopedia for all aspects of visual arts worldwide from prehistory to present.

### **Index to 19<sup>th</sup> Century American Art Periodicals**

The *Index to Nineteenth-Century American Art Periodicals* is the only online index to art periodicals published in the U.S. during the 19th century. Entire journal contents are indexed — including illustrations and advertisements.

### **JSTOR**

An archive of over 500 scholarly journals offering full-content multidisciplinary and discipline-specific collections, going all the way back to the first issue for selected journals. Many journals covering Classical studies, area studies, anthropology, architecture, archaeology, and art history are available – including *Art Bulletin*, *Art Journal*, *Burlington Magazine*, *Journal of Hellenic Studies*, and *Journal of Roman Studies*.

### **Periodicals Index Online (PIO) & Periodicals Archive Online (PAO)**

Search PIO for citations from 4,750+ periodicals spanning 1665-1995 (including some with full text). To search only within the full text of articles or if only interested in articles where full text is available (from 250+ periodicals covering 1802-1995), use the separate PAO interface.
