

## Electronic Theses and Dissertations (ETD's) at UF Background and Facts

ETD pilot project began in 1998.

ETD's became required in Fall of 2001.

Restricted content no longer immediately forwarded to Proquest after December of 2006. Content forwarded to Proquest whenever restriction ends.

Dissertations no longer required to be published at Proquest *starting with* December of 2007.

Definitions:

**Embargo:** PDF content of title available to anyone physically located in UF Library OR coming into the Library web site from the UF IP pool. Title, author, bibliographic data, and abstract, available to the WORLD via Library catalog.

**Secret:** PDF content not available to anyone. Nothing pertaining to title displays in Library catalog.
