Your Gator 1 card serves as your library card. Be sure to have it activated at a circulation desk, or by submitting an online form. Your Gator 1 number is used for logging on to library computers, connecting from off-campus, renewing checked out books, etc.

Photocopying and Computer and Microform Printing are available at all Libraries, using copy cards (not cash). Reusable copy cards may be purchased at vending machines in the Libraries with bills (\$1 up to \$20). Thirty-five cents of the initial purchase price pays for the card. Additional value may be added at the dispenser. The Libraries do not make change.

Interlibrary Loan will help you obtain articles, books, and other materials not owned at UF. Submit requests electronically by selecting ILLiad at <<http://illiad.uflib.ufl.edu/illiad/>>. Pick up materials at the Library West circulation desk.

Special services are available for users with disabilities.
